

Half Marathon for Ethiopia



Wednesday 7 October 2009 12 noon for 12.30pm start at Cirencester College

Cirencester College is running its second half marathon event to raise awareness of the difficulties and pressures faced by runners within Ethiopia.

The event is run in small teams with the baton changing hands after every 0.5/1 or 2 km. Currently the world record for the half marathon is *58 minutes 33 seconds* for men and *1 hour 6 minutes 25 seconds* for women. Running in a relay format will give teams a more realistic chance of matching or hopefully beating these times!
